Contributions

For tours and parking at the main entrance: \$3 per person.

Photo sessions with no tour and 15 minutes of parking down the hill: 50¢ per person.

In 2012, this fare will rise up to 1\$ per person.

R.R.V.M. c.G-2 – City of Montréal

"2. No guided tours may be conducted without the permit referred to in article 7.

5. A pilgrimage involving the tour of more than one place of worship or other places in the city is a guided tour; guides must hold the permit provided for in article 7."

- During the tour
Make sure the people in your group are properly dressed.
Do not hold any tours during masses.
Do not take photos during masses.
Keep your voice down out of respect for this place of worship.
Ensure cellular phones are switched off.
Do not bring food or drink.
