## Sample schedule of a day of pilgrimage

- ☞ **9:30 AM Arrival** : brief encounter with your guide or a religious
- ☞ **9:45 AM Begin your visit** : Votive Chapel, Crypt Church (moment of contemplation and prayer), tomb of Brother André, exhibit on the life of Brother André, Basilica, Saint André Besette Chapel, Blessed Sacrament Chapel, Original Chapel, time for silent meditation
- ☞ **11:30 Free time** : personal devotions, Sacrament of Reconciliation, consultation
- ☞ **12:15 Mass** in English in the Crypt Church
- ☞ **1:00 Lunch time** : It is advised to pre-order a lunch menu for your group
- ☞ **2:00 Free time** : visit to the gift shop
- ☞ **2:45 PM Gather** for a final moment of prayer and for a blessing

Groups can enrich their spiritual journey by visiting the **Gardens of the Way of the Cross**, located in a wooded area near the Basilica. It is a quiet and relaxing place for meditation. (May to October)

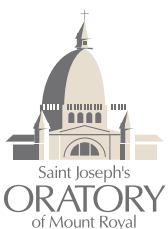


## SPECIAL ACTIVITIES ON DEMAND FOR AN OUTSTANDING VISIT
