REASONS TO CELEBRATE!

Saint Joseph was chosen as Canada's patron saint and protector of its nascent Church 400 years ago. In the Saint Joseph's Oratory of Mount Royal Basilica, this four-century-old devotion is on display through its colourful contemporary stained glass. It stands as a connection between past and present, where Joseph's brilliant figure supports and lights the way for the people who gather at the Oratory to celebrate their faith.

This 4th centenary of the country's consecration to Saint Joseph will be highlighted from the start of the Novena on March 10 until October 19, the anniversary of the Oratory's foundation. Father Michael DeLaney, CSC, Rector of the Oratory, sent a major invitation throughout Canada's dioceses in hopes of making Saint Joseph's national sanctuary an essential destination for all 2024 travel plans.

THE BASILICA: 100 YEARS OF HISTORY!

There is another anniversary, which cannot pass unmarked: one hundred years ago, on August 31, 1924, during the 3rd centenary celebrations, the cornerstone of the future Basilica of Saint Joseph's Oratory of Mount Royal was blessed. The solemn gesture marked the official launch of construction work on the sanctuary's highest church. It was a great and visionary architectural project; a monument to faith, a grand temple to Saint Joseph that the public wanted to build.

The Côte-des-Neiges pilgrimage site was starting a new era. Brother André's dream would take on new proportions. By definition, an oratory may be a small place of worship, but ours on Mount Royal would be colossal. Built over many decades, the Oratory's Basilica became a fixture of the Montréal skyline and of the constellation of the Canadian Church. From this beacon of Christian faith, the light of devotion to Saint Joseph would shine like never before.

Building the Saint Joseph's Oratory Basilica was the project of generations, which gathered thousands of donors from 1924 all the way up to today, because they believed in making their grand project a reality on Mount Royal's northern side.


